# **! SAMPLE PROCESSING TIMES**

A reminder that you need to adhere to the sample processing times outlined in the protocol and the SIV training;

# All CSF processing must start within 15 minutes of sample collection

# We also ask that blood processing must start within 15 minutes of blood collection

In order to achieve these targets, you may need to take the CSF to the lab first separately from the blood if waiting for the blood collection means that it delays start of CSF processing.

The CSF is spun in the centrifuge at 4°C and as soon as it is finished then the plasma can go in at 4°C also. The serum must be spun in a separate centrifuge that is already at room temperature.

If there are any issues with meeting these targets, then CSF must always be prioritised and we ask that you write a comment explaining the delays on the EDC for us to read during remote monitoring.

Please get in contact with Central Coordination if you can foresee any issues with this.
